

Health and Safety Policy Statement

The Land Sheriffs are a provider of general security services (static, mobile, covert, surveillance, foot patrol) and are specialists in railway security.

We at Land Sheriffs are aware that our activities, products and services could cause ill health or injury to our staff, or others that could be affected by our undertaking. We are committed to managing the risk of such ill health or injury so far as reasonably practicable.

More specifically, we commit to:

- Provide adequate & sufficient resources to maintain health and safety
- Ensure risk assessments are conducted and reviewed
- Consult with employees and other stakeholders on matters affecting their health and safety
- Provide and maintain systems of work which are safe and without risk to health
- Use, handle, store and transport articles and substances, provided for use at work, safely and without risk to health
- Provide employees with the information, instruction, training and supervision necessary to secure their safety and health at work and that of others who may be affected by their actions
- Carry out health surveillance, where required by risk assessment
- Ensure that all machinery, plant and equipment is fit for purpose, maintained and in a safe condition
- Provide adequate arrangements for welfare facilities at work
- Keep the workplace safe and ensure that access and egress routes are safe and without risk to health
- Monitor safety performance to maintain standards.
- Setting and monitoring safety objectives
- Continual improvement in safety performance

We require our employees, and those working on our behalf, to:

- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety, and that of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions while at work
- Cooperate with others in the company to fulfil our statutory duties and policy obligations
- Not interfere with, misuse or wilfully damage anything provided in the interest of health and safety
- Refuse to work if they believe health and safety will be compromised

To ensure that this policy is effective, we will:

- Review it annually or when significant changes occur
- Make any resulting changes known to employees and others that could be affected by it
- Maintain a formal management system to continually improve health and safety performance
